5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

5.1. Licencing Requirements

- The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race (C1 or C2) Grade Competition Licence
- If the Entrant is not the driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 New Drivers

Any drivers who have not previously competed at the Manfeild Race Circuit must indicate the fact on their entry form and attend the New Drivers Briefing session. **The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, top floor of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 24th February at 0830.**

5.3 Competitor Understanding

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations. As well as Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Conduct

6 DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Scrutineering Audit Inspection

All drivers are required to present their vehicle log books to the scrutineers for authorisation in the Scrutineering Shed midway along the Dummy and have audits completed **BEFORE** attending Documentation.

The scrutineers will be available at the following times:

7 POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS

- Pursuant to the National Sporting Code article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 120 entries received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.
- Should there be less than 10 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Invited Classes of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

8 GENERAL INFORMATION

8.1 Trailer Parking

All trailers must be removed to the designated trailer parking area near the Rata Street entrance or on the western side of the Stadium car park

8.2 Service Vehicles

- Only service vehicles are permitted in the pit paddock area. All other cars to the Stadium car park please.

8.3 Site Access

- Access to the circuit is via Rata Street Entrance and the South Street entrance.

8.4 Transponder Timing

- Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Loss or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense. All hire transponders must be returned to track office at the conclusion of racing.
- If you own your own transponder please ensure the transponder number is recorded on your entry form. No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly. You will be spoken to by a CRO if your transponder is not working.

8.5 Friday Testing

- Friday 23/02/2018 is test day run by the Manawatu Car Club starting at 0900 and finishing at 1700. Lunch break is from around 1200 to 1300
- Test sessions will be grouped according to lap time
- The cost is \$100 payable at sign-on in the Track Office. After 1pm half-day rate of \$60 applies.
- All entry to the test day is via Rata Street

8.6 Drivers Briefing

- A Written Drivers Briefing will be distributed at documentation.
- A full Drivers' Briefing will be held on Saturday 24/02/2018 at 0900 by the outside stairs next to the Control Tower. Attendance is compulsory.
- **The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, top floor of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 24/02/2018 at 0830.**

8.7 Camping

- Overnight camping is allowed on Friday and Saturday. There are several caravan-type power points in the paddock area. Shower and toilet facilities are available around the site. Contact Jeff Braid 027 477 3337 manawatucarclub@xtra.co.nz.

8.8 Fuel Availability

No fuel is available at the circuit. No fuel is to be stored fuel in your pits overnight. See 9 FUEL.

8.9 Meeting Rides

- Meeting Rides may be conducted at the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24/02/2018 time and conditions dependent. This will be at the sole discretion of the Meeting organizers. Meeting rides will be run according to Appendix Four, Schedule Z Article 24. The Rules/Guidelines and Indemnity Forms will be available in the Track Office.

9 Pit Paddock and Pit Lane Rules

- Animals are NOT allowed within the Manfeild Park facility
- No person under the age of 16 is allowed in the Pit Lane area unless a competitor
- Closed toed shoes MUST be worn in the Pit Lane area.
- WORN RACE TYRES AND CAR PARTS** must be removed from the venue by the competitor
- ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES** in use at the venue must be tagged and tested according to the requirements in Regulation 26 of the Electrical (Safety) Regulations 2010.
- PIT BIKES, QUAD BIKES AND SIDE-BY SIDES** may only be operated by licenced drivers wearing approved helmets

9 FUEL

Competitors are required to follow the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full detail of this Code is found here: <http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel>. This Code has been developed by MotorSport New Zealand and is intended primarily for the use of fuels at events organised by MotorSport New Zealand. The aim of this Code is to reduce risk with fuel and help prevent accidental damage or injury to people, property and the environment.

PLEASE NOTE: 40 litres fuel maximum per pit bay. No fuel (or other bulk flammable liquids) apart from that which is in the competition vehicle can be stored in individual pit bays overnight.
