5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

5.1. <u>Licencing Requirements</u>

- The driver must hold as a minimum a of a C1 or C2 Grade Competition Licence
- If the Entrant is not the driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 New Drivers

Any driver(s) who has not previously competed at the Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park must tick in the box on the entry form and attend the New Drivers Briefing session.

5.3 Competitor Understanding

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations. Also Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Conduct.

6 DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Documentation &Scrutineering Audit Inspection

Documentation will be in Documentation Room, ground floor of the pit lane complex.

Scrutineering will take place in Garage 1 of the Pit Lane complex.

Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit Safety audit scrutineering must be completed prior to qualifying and/or racing.

7 POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS

- Pursuant to the National Sporting Code article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 60 entries received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.
- Should there be less than 10 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Invited Classes of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

8 GENERAL INFORMATION

8.1 Drivers Briefing

- Drivers Briefing will be held on Saturday 19th November at 08.30am outside the Documentation Office on the Ground Floor.
- The New Drivers briefing will be held after this at the same location.
- Drivers briefing for Honda Cup Drivers will be held on Sunday 1st November at 08:15am. The New Drivers briefing will be held after this at the same location.

8.2 Transponder Timing

- Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Loss or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense.
- If you own your own transponder please ensure the transponder number is recorded on your entry form.
- No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly. You will be shown a
 board and your number from the Starters Stand during Qualifying, or spoken to by a CRO if your transponder is not
 working.

8.3 Friday Testing (if available)

8.4 Garage Hire

8.5 Camping - Friday & Saturday night ONLY

- Overnight camping is allowed Friday and Saturday night ONLY.
- Security will be on site in the Pit Paddock area from 7pm 7am Saturday night.

8.6 Fuel Availability & Storage

No fuel is available at the circuit. Please refer to the Fuel Handling Requirements regarding your pit area. Copies of this are available from the Documentation Office.

8.7 Pit Paddock and Competition Rules

- Dogs are NOT allowed within the Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park facility.
- No person under the age of 16 is allowed in the Pit Lane/Dummy Grid areas.
- Closed toed shoes MUST be worn in the Pit Lane/Dummy Grid areas.
- The entire area from the ticketing gates to the race circuit is SMOKE FREE. Smoking is only permitted in the spectator stands and the grass area in the pit paddock
- Children's Bicycles, Skateboards and Scooters may be confiscated if considered a nuisance during the event.
 They will be returned at the conclusion of racing per day.
- Nothing is to be hammered into the Pit Paddock seal. If you are observed doing this you will be asked to remove them and charged with the repair costs.

Please note that you must be out of the park by 18.00 hours on Sunday night
