Key Points

1. This applies to vehicles purchased new in New Zealand direct from the manufacturer.
2. The Motor Industry Association notes that for Japanese used import vehicles ethanol blends over 3 per cent are not recommended.
3. The Independent Motor Vehicle Dealers Association endorses the use of Gull Force 10 for used vehicles imported from Japan which are designed to run on 98 octane fuel.
4. There is ongoing government research on the suitability of 10% ethanol blends with Japanese imported vehicles. Results to date shows no signs of corrosion of engine parts under stressful conditions.
5. Both Gull Regular Plus and Gull Force 10 contains an international corrosion inhibitor to further protect your vehicle.
6. Gull Regular Plus and Gull Force 10 are of the highest standard and in addition, Gull warranties all Gull fuel to meet New Zealand fuel specifications.
